These stories sought to show readers what it was like for residents of Los Angeles who were fighting to stay housed in a region that faces a dire homelessness crisis and has some of the highest housing costs in the nation, with a median rent of more than \$2,000 a month.

The stories began by observing the county's bustling eviction courts and continued throughout the year, with intimate portraits of residents fighting against long odds to keep their homes in the face of eviction, buyout efforts and harassment.
